

2005-2006 Guidelines for the Eleanor B. and Richard Fisher Episcopal Scholarship

1. An applicant for any type of scholarship **must complete an application form.**
2. All scholarships will be for **post secondary education**, either at an accredited college/university or technical school, **with the intention of receiving a degree, diploma or certification.**
3. Scholarships will be offered to all St. Michael's youth who are confirmed and active members of the parish regardless of need as long as the student **maintains a minimum 2.0 grade point average.**
4. **Scholarships will be given with a maximum of \$300.00 per semester, for a maximum of two(2) semesters per year.** Applicants attending schools on the quarter system will be given a maximum of \$300.00 twice a year for a total of \$600.00 per calendar year.
5. **The Fisher Scholarships** may be used for graduate study programs, depending upon need and availability of funding.
6. Scholarships for summer camps, such as Honey Creek and/or Episcopal sponsored summer camps, are available for St. Michael's youth. These scholarships will not exceed \$150.00 per child, per summer.
7. Youth attending Honey Creek Weekends may be awarded scholarships in the amount of \$25.00.
8. Lay ministries and other adults attending conferences may apply for a scholarship, if needed.
9. There is an **Eleanor B. and Richard Fisher Seminary Scholarship** to benefit confirmed, active members of St. Michael's that are attending seminary with the intention of ordination in the Episcopal Church. There may be a variance of funding between this special scholarship and all other Fisher scholarships.
10. **The Scholarship Committee reserves the right in certain circumstances to take pastoral concerns into consideration and to act accordingly.**
